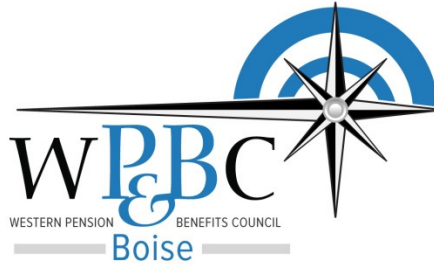

Managing Retirement Risk in a Volatile Market

Robert Maynard – Chief Investment Officer for the Public Employee Retirement System of Idaho

About Our Topic:

In this session, Robert will shed some light on how we can better manage investment risk in both 401(k) plans and defined benefit plans.

About Our Speaker:

Robert Maynard is Chief Investment Officer for the \$15 billion Public Employee Retirement System of Idaho, where he is responsible for all investment activities of the organization. He has served in that position since 1992. Previously he served as Deputy Executive Director of the Alaska Permanent Fund Corporation, and as Assistant Attorney General for the State of Alaska.

Mr. Maynard has been recognized for his investment activities on a number of occasions, including being named Chief Investment Officer of the Year by the Institute for Fiduciary Education, receiving the Richard L. Stoddard Award for outstanding contributions to the investment of public funds (awarded by other state Chief Investment Officers), and also receiving the Lifetime Achievement Award for Public Fund Investing (collectively awarded by Institutional Investor Press, Information Management Network, and the Money Management Letter). Mr. Maynard has also been named as one of the 100 most influential global investors by Asset International CIO magazine, as one of the Sovereign Wealth Fund Institute's global 100 "most significant and impactful public investor executives", and by Trusted Insight as one of the "Top 30 Chief Investment Officers".
